

Copyright Agency - Guidelines for University Copyright, Print & Distribution

Under Part VB of the Copyright Act and the CAL (Copyright Agency Limited) The Universities can copy and make available to students Course Readers from published journals and books strictly for educational purposes.

Access to materials copied under Part VB must be limited to University Staff and Students only. Copies must not be distributed to external users, posted on any public access websites or blogs, YouTube or Facebook etc.

Most importantly, Readers must not be sold to members of the public who are not enrolled as a current & valid student at the university.

Under the current Copyright Act and the Universities subsequent CAL Licence Agreement Readers can only be sold or distributed to current & valid enrolled students who hold a current & valid Student ID card as evidence.

This information can be accessed from all university websites under Copyright Regulations.

Students must display a current Student ID card upon purchase of any copyright material.

Please have your Student ID card ready to avoid delays at the counter.
